SUBJECT: Expulsion Order

1. Effective this date you are both expelled from the GUARDIANS BROTHERHOOD INCORPORATED, MAINSTREAM and as such, your respective promotions to the Rank of National Founder is hereby nullified.
2. You have both committed grievous and very serious offense inimical and detrimental to the Brotherhood, by defying the Authority of the Regional Founder Macacna "NF Mac" Urabang by not presenting your side in an investigation per order emanating from the Acting Prime Minister.
3. You also rebuffed the Order of the undersigned Acting Prime Minister to report to him at Sibugay Grand Plaza Hotel last December 6, 2008 and instead insisted that he see me at 4th East Rosario Heights, Iligan City which violates protocol and a sign of arrogance on your part.
4. The serious accusations against you therefore can now be construed as true based on the testimonials of Founders and Chapter Officers and because you refuse to show up during the two (2) sessions of the investigations conducted by the Regional Founder upon Orders of the undersigned Acting Prime Minister you therefore waived your right to be heard thereby forfeiting all your rights to be heard and confront your accusers.

5. Collecting exorbitant amount for ID's at Five Hundred Thirty Pesos (Php 530.00), illegal Promotions to the Rank of RMG and Founders is a gross violation of the Provisions of the GBI By Laws.
6. Other collections such as Fifty Pesos (Php 50.00) Federal Fee for New Applicants is also illegal and a corrupt practice so with illegal markings conducted by both of you since you pocketed these collections without issuing official GBI receipts; also for the collection of Thirty Pesos (Php 30.00) registration fee for the Red Book.
7. Most serious of all these anomalous transactions is the conduct of Illegal Markings and Extorting Traveling Expenses in the amount of Three Thousand One Hundred Thirty Pesos (Php 3,130.00) which constituted a criminal offense and a very serious one for DISHONESTY.
8. Above premises being considered, you are hereby advised to clear your name, remit all collections illegally collected or appropriate charges will be filed in court. You are both banned from any and all activities regionwide.
